Worse, it harkened back to the days of Eugenics, a philosophy once advocated here in North America and put into practice by the Nazis. dler. Now 15, Jacob is described as one of the brightest minds in Physics today and has moved to Waterloo to study at the famed Perimeter Institute, founded by Blackberry founder Mike Lazaridis. His mother, Kristine has chronicled the family's journey in the book "The Spark. A Mother's Story of Nurturing Genius."

Jacob has a deep passion for mathematics and physics but wears flip flops as he has trouble tying his shoes. But his mind is subtle in its grasp of questions that most of us can barely contemplate. Our societal values allow all to participate in life. We all benefit from the diversity and pure mystery of the human experience.
