Police subdue axe-wielding man

Halton Police have charged a 53year-old Georgetown man, who was subdued by officers using a Taser, after the suspect allegedly brandished an axe in the Guelph St. police station parking lot Thursday.

Police say about 1:30 p.m. a man drove his vehicle into the police parking area at the police station, got out of the car, and set an axe on his car roof.

Two nearby officers approached the man and after a brief interaction, a sergeant used the Taser on the man and officers were able to take him into custody without further incident.

The man was transported to hospital and admitted under the provisions of the Mental Health Act. He was subsequently re-examined by medical personnel and released back into police custody the next day.

He was taken for a bail hearing and remains in custody.

Charged with assault police and weapons dangerous is Wieslaw Napiontek of Halton Hills.
