Sprinkler damages new hospital ED

The extent of water damage in Georgetown Hospital's Emergency Department is being assessed after a sprinkler in the mechanical area above it activated early Saturday morning.

But Cindy McDonell, the hospital's COO, said at no time during the incident did they have to shut the ED down.

"Patient care was not compromised," said McDonell. She added patients in the ED were moved into another area of the hospital when the water was coming down.

McDonell said its unknown why the sprinkler went off about 2 a.m. It is currently being investigated.

Water came through the ceiling of the ED and down some walls. As a result, seven treatment spaces that were empty at the time have been closed while the damage is being assessed.

McDonell said they would have to replace some ceiling tiles and perhaps some walls. Impacted equipment located on the walls in the affected rooms is being tested for damage.

"We don't know the extent of the costs, that hasn't been determined," said McDonell. She added, "we have insurance for this."

She said the ED's Trauma Room, Adult Resuscitation Room, Triage and computers were not affected by the incident.

She credited the fire department with being "really responsive."
