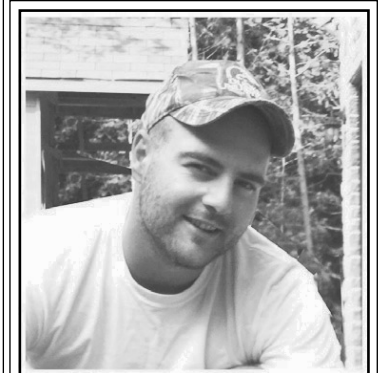

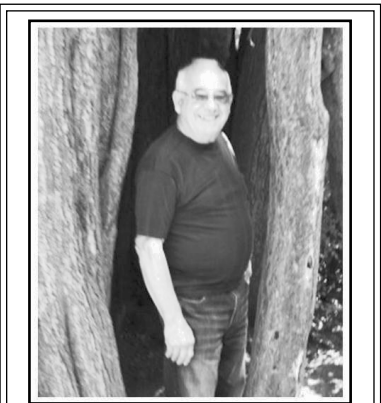
FRENCH, Nathan Wesley Kirkwood

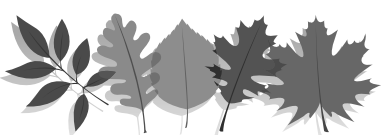
