Etobicoke driver gets fine, ban for fatal collision

An Etobicoke man who was found guilty of careless driving earlier this year in the February 2011 collision that claimed the life of pedestrian Donna Reid of Georgetown, was fined and received a one-year driving prohibition in Burlington Court recently.

On Nov. 19 Douglas Wehnde, 53, received a \$2,500 fine and 24 months probation that prohibits him from driving for the first 12 months except to take a safe driving course, and permits him to drive only for work or emergencies in the last 12 months.

Wehnde, 53, was driving a pickup

truck that struck and killed pedestrian Reid, 48, who had a developmental disability, while she was crossing Mountainview Rd. near Todd Rd.

Wehnde, owner/manager of Ziebart Uniglass, had just picked up the new truck and was taking it for rust proofing when Reid was struck.
