The Halton Waste Management Site (HWMS) provides Halton residents with a convenient "one-stop" location for reuse, recycling and proper waste disposal.

- ✓ Loads must be sorted by material type. Pre-sort loads for quick and easy unloading.
- ✓ Remove all fluids (e.g. gas, oil) from gas powered equipment such as lawnmowers.
- Arrange for additional assistance to help unload heavy material, if required.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Depot

Household hazardous waste can injure waste collectors and can damage the environment if disposed of improperly. Household hazardous waste must not be put in the garbage or poured down the drain.



There is a 20 litre maximum per visit. No commercial hazardous waste can be accepted.
