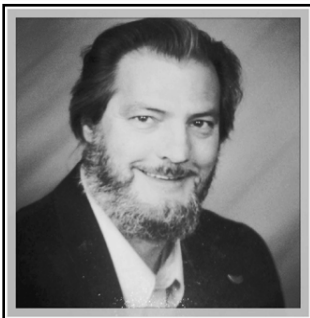


ESCOTT, Ilene
