The resurfacing will cost approximately \$313,000.


The work will be done on Fourth Line between 15 and 17 Sideroads.

Lightworks Inc. of Aurora was awarded the contract by the Town to supply and install new lighting at Mold-Masters Sports-Plex for approximately \$58,000.

The company will be replacing the metal halide lights at the two existing ice pads. The new lights should improve the lighting levels for the rinks and be much more energy efficient—reducing hydro costs.
