Year. *My Faith My All* also was awarded Canadian Southern Gospel Song of The Year at the 2005 Covenant Awards. Recent releases include *Faith of Our Fathers* and *I Rest My Case at the Cross*. Each of these releases has been recognized with multiple nominations and the song *God's Amazing Grace* was awarded "Canadian Southern Gospel Song of the Year" at the 2007 Covenant Awards.
