GRASSLAND BIRD SURVEY

volunteers needed for a breeding bird survey of meadow habitat





CVC is looking for volunteers who can identify grassland birds by sight and by ear. CVC is organizing a monitoring 'blitz' of meadow habitat in the middle and upper portions of the Credit River watershed to gather more information about at-risk grassland bird species.

This is a one-day event in June that will include an earlier two-hour training session. Volunteers will be put into teams and surveys will be conducted from the roadside using a 'point-count' method.
