Smith has taught classes and workshops on life drawing, portraiture and figurative abstraction for over 20 years and has been on the faculty of the Ontario College of Art and Design, The Koffler Centre for the Arts, Haliburton School of The Arts, Curry's Art School, Visual Arts Mississauga and Neilson Park Creative Centre as well as conducting Master Classes in his own studio.

This exciting, once-a-month figure workshop will challenge painters and drawers of all experience levels to up their game with unusual and fun projects. Band is a local artist who is currently exhibiting in the Main Street Inn. He is teaching a course in watercolours on Mondays during the mornings. For anyone who would like to learn the rudiments of watercolour painting or requires a refresher course, this is a must.

Band will teach you: Introduction to materials and drawing approaches. Working from photographs, transferring images to larger paper, handling clean flat washes in a landscape, landscape with trees and

water (reflections), studying the shapes and values in glass, still life with flowing fabric and glass, fast simple landscapes with clouds, flowers and potted plants, snow, trees, rail fence, and shadows. <http://www.williambandstudio.com>

Indulge yourself in a safe and highly creative environment with lots of individual instruction and personal critiques that will challenge you to further develop your artistic vision and practice. This open studio is a wonderful opportunity that is structured around one-on-one consultation with an instructor/mentor on materials, media, techniques, concepts, and process of "idea to execution".

Start projects or a body of new work and learn to assess the evolution of your work and others. Emphasis will be placed on individual expression and the importance of creative process over product. At the end of each class you will have at least one completed printed work ready for framing.
