

# Road construction season begins

Starting this spring, select streets throughout Halton Hills will benefit from road resurfacing, and where needed, road reconstruction. This construction project is known as ROADS 2014.

Concurrent with the Town's work, Halton Region will be completing water and wastewater projects in the same area.

Each year, the Town's Pavement Management Construction and Capital Works program renews and improves the roads across Halton Hills. In 2013, the focus was on upgrading roads in Ward 3.

"The Town of Halton Hills is continuing its efforts to keep our roads in good repair," said Mayor Rick Bonnette.

"We know that each street will experience some disruption during construction, but the results of ROADS 2014 will improve residents' quality of life for years to come."

### Streets affected by ROADS 2014

The following streets will have road work completed this season by the Town's contractor. This work will be supervised and administered by Town staff.

- 17 Sideroad - Fourth Line to 300 m west of Sixth Line - Asphalt resurfacing
- 22 Sideroad East of Tenth Line - Slope stability
- 32 Sideroad 400 m East of Fourth Line - Knoll removal, resurfacing, landscaping
- Bain Ct. - Delrex Blvd. to End - Road resurfacing
- Byron St., Edward St. to Windsor Rd. - Wastewater main
- Charles St., Church St. to Maple Ave. - Water & wastewater main replacement and resurfacing
- Cherry St. - Arletta St. to Ewing St. - Water & wastewater main construction
- Cleaveholm Dr. - Mary St. to Henry St. - Wastewater main
- Danridge Cres. - Metcalfe Ct. to Metcalfe Ct. - Watermain and road resurfacing
- Eden Place - Mountainview Rd. South to End - Wastewater main, watermain & road resurfacing



- Ewing Street - Main Street to Hewson Crescent - Water & wastewater main construction and road resurfacing
- Fourth Line - 15 Sideroad to 10 Sideroad - Upgrade to asphalt
- Eighth Line and 15 Sideroad - intersection of Eighth Line and 15 Sideroad - Traffic Signal
- Gairey Dr. - Delrex Blvd. to Weber Dr. - Road reconstruction
- Guelph St. Service Road - Guelph St. to Hall Road - Road resurfacing
- Hawks Place - Delrex Blvd. to End - Road resurfacing
- Henry St. - Mary St. to Main St. North - Wastewater main
- Hewson Cres. - Ewing St. to Ewing St. - Water & wastewater main construction & road resurfacing

- Lewis St. - Delrex Blvd. to Pennington Cres. - Watermain & road resurfacing
- Mackenzie Dr. - Delrex Blvd. to Rexway Dr. - Wastewater main & road reconstruction
- Metcalfe Ct. - Delrex Blvd. to End - Watermain & road resurfacing
- Miller Dr. - Eighth Line to Argyll Rd. - Bike lane implementation

- Weber Dr. - Delrex Blvd. to Delrex Blvd. - Road resurfacing

Residents will experience some disruption to their lives during the roadwork. Anyone who has concerns about dust, noise or other construction issues is asked to go to [www.haltonhills.ca/roads2014](http://www.haltonhills.ca/roads2014) to receive more information. Should ROADS 2014 be delayed by factors such as weather, residents will receive a hand-delivered notice from the Town explaining the details of the delay.

"We are scheduling ROADS 2014 to move efficiently through the town streets that need renewal or improvements. This investment in Halton Hills is a priority project which will keep our roads safe and in top condition," said Chris Mills, Director of Infrastructure Services.
