## NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT CHARGE BY-LAW

**MEETING TO BE HELD ON  
JUNE 3, 2014 AT 7:30 P.M.  
Halton Catholic District School Board  
802 Drury Lane, Burlington, Ontario**

Take notice that the Halton Catholic District School Board proposes to amend its 2013 Education Development Charge By-Law (the “2013 By-law”), which came in to effect on June 24, 2013.

The schedule of education development charges imposed by the by-law is as follows:

- Charge on residential development : \$1,484.00 per dwelling unit
- Charge on non-residential development : \$0.38 per square foot (\$4.09 per square metre) of gross floor area

The proposed amending by-law will increase the charge on residential development to \$1,839.00 per dwelling unit and the charge on non-residential development to \$0.47 per square foot (\$5.06 per square metre) of gross floor area. The increase in the charge is due to an increase in the education land costs and servicing costs that the Board has incurred over those estimated when the 2013 By-law was passed.

The 2013 By-law referred to above applies to all lands in the Regional Municipality of Halton. Accordingly, a key map showing the location of the land subject to the said by-law is not provided as part of this notice.

The Board will consider the proposed amending by-law at a public meeting to be held on June 3, 2014 at 8:00 P.M. in the Board Room of the Halton Catholic District School Board at 802 Drury Lane, Burlington, Ontario. All interested persons are invited to attend the public meeting.

Should an amending by-law be passed on such date, collection of education development charges pursuant to the By-law, as amended, will commence on June 8, 2014.

A copy of the proposed amending by-law, the education development charge background study in connection with the 2013 By-law and information concerning the proposed amendment will be available on or after May 15, 2014 at the Board’s administration offices, 802 Drury Lane, Burlington, Ontario, during regular business hours or on the Board’s Website at [www.hcdsb.org](http://www.hcdsb.org).

The Board would appreciate receiving on or before May 27, 2014 written submissions on the proposed amending by-law so they may be distributed to the trustees. ## NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT CHARGE BY-LAW THE HALTON DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD PUBLIC MEETING ON JUNE 4, 2014 at 7:00 P.M.

Take notice that the Halton District School Board (the “Board”) proposes to amend the Halton District School Board Education Development Charges By-law, 2013 (the “By-law”), which came into effect on June 24, 2013.

The schedule of education development charges now imposed by the By-law is as follows:

Charge on residential development	\$2,691.00 per dwelling unit
Charge on non-residential development:	\$0.69 per square foot (\$7.43 per square metre) of gross floor area

The proposed amending by-law will increase the charge on residential development to \$3,380 per dwelling unit and the charge on non-residential development to \$0.87 per square foot (\$9.36 per square metre) of gross floor area. The increase is due to an increase in the education land costs incurred by the Board over those estimated when the By-law was passed in 2013.

The By-law applies to all lands in the Regional Municipality of Halton. Accordingly, a key map showing the location of the land subject to the By-law is not provided as part of this notice.

The Board will consider the proposed amending by-law at the meeting of the Board to be held on June 4, 2014, at 7:00 p.m. at the J.W. Singleton Centre, 2050 Guelph Line, Burlington, Ontario.

Should an amending by-law be passed on such date, collection of education development charges pursuant to the By-law, as amended, will commence on June 9, 2014.

If a person wishes to address the Board at the meeting, he or she is requested to advise the Board on or before noon, May 27, 2014. Any written submissions on the proposed amending by-law must be received on or before noon, May 29, 2014, in order that they may be distributed to trustees. All submissions received in writing and those opinions expressed at the meeting will be considered prior to a decision by the Board to amend the By-law.
