Future garden works include additional plantings to frame the sculpture and the existing columbarium area.

"I'm pleased to see this addition to the Greenwood Cemetery," said Mayor Rick Bonnette.

"It's important that our local artists contribute to such important outdoor spaces that reflect our local cultural heritage."

Councillors Bob Inglis and Jon Hurst were also on hand to see the installation as representatives of the Citizens Cemetery Advisory Committee.

The cemetery works are part of an overall program overseen by the Town as part of its role in cemetery services.

A Cemetery Guide is available to residents to explain interment options, pricing and ornamentation.

Filled with photos and diagrams, the guide illustrates the various options available to residents when purchasing an interment site, often in consultation with local funeral homes.
