Canadian forces that helped repatriate those countries during World War II.

"Just listening to the story of Mr. Chong, I don't think we can go through the Canadian mosaic and not be touched by the evidence and the contributions that our veterans

have given and this gesture by Halton Hills is exceptional," said an emotional Supt. Penney.

Former Conception Bay South Mayor Woody French, overseer of the first Canadian community to adopt the Community Covenant, made the trip to Newfoundland to attend the Georgetown ceremony.
