Raiders assess need for change

Ontario Junior Hockey League teams will have some difficult decisions to make with the Jan. 10 cutdown date looming and the first-place Georgetown Raiders are pondering whether they have to make any changes at all.

Carrying a seven-point lead over Oakville and the Toronto Patriots in the South/West Conference standings with three games in hand on both clubs, Georgetown head coach & GM Greg Walters is hesitant to tinker with a lineup that's headed into January with a 23-4-3-5 record, behind only Aurora and Cobourg amongst the OJHL's elite.

The Raiders have only made a couple of roster moves since training camp and veteran blueliner Nick Iafrate was the only injured player prior to the holiday break as the former St. Michael's Buzzer recovers from a broken thumb.

"It'd be tough to (make changes) but obviously we have to look around," said Walters.

"There's going to be some movement throughout the league so we'll be listening, but the big thing is we don't want to mess

around with the chemistry inside our room. Last year, the guys were close and this year it seems like they're even closer. They're all in it for one reason."

Next up for the Raiders is a home date this Saturday at 7:30 p.m. with the Trenton Golden Hawks, an East Division front-runner.

And while Georgetown is lumped in the West Division with some of the league's weaker teams, the Raiders have managed to allow the fewest goals against with just 77 in 35 games and possess the league's leading point-getter in captain Steve Hladin.

Walters also has the luxury of employing two netminders in the OJHL's top five statistically, with 16-year-old rookie Jack LaFontaine posting a 15-3-1 record and a 1.98 goals-against average and 20-year-old Marc Williams registering four shutouts and a 2.34 GAA.

"We're lucky to have two number ones," surmised Walters.

"They've both bought into it and have been very supportive of each other."
