The group starting in Acton will ride to the Halton Hills Civic Centre and join with those starting there. The ride will travel through the beautiful back roads of Halton Hills via the quaint village of Limehouse.

There will be no road closures for this ride. This is a recreational ride but does involve some challenging hills as the route progresses up the Niagara Escarpment to Acton.

Riders will be divided into groups de-

pending on average speed of cycling. Please arrive early in order to sign the waiver, get instructions and be organized into groups.

There are two routes, a 22-km round trip and a more challenging 50-km advanced route.
