## The minimum wage is going up.

#### Here's what you need to know: Minimum Wage Rate June 1, 2014 to As of October 1, **September 30, 2015** 2015 **General Minimum Wage** \$11.00 per hour **\$11.25** per hour \$10.30 per hour **\$10.55** per hour Student Minimum Wage: Students under 18 and working 28 hours per week or less when school is in session, or work during a school break or summer holidays Liquor Servers Minimum Wage \$9.55 per hour **\$9.80** per hour **Hunting and Fishing Guides Minimum Wage:** \$55.00 \$56.30 Rate for working less than five consecutive hours **Hunting and Fishing Guides Minimum Wage:** \$110.00 \$112.60 Rate for working five or more hours in a day whether or not the hours are consecutive Homeworkers Wage: \$12.10 per hour **\$12.40** per hour Employees doing paid work in their own home for an employer

On October 1, 2015, the general minimum wage will increase to \$11.25, from the current rate of \$11.00. The minimum wage will be reviewed on a yearly basis. The rates will be published by April 1st and come into effect on October 1st of the same year.
