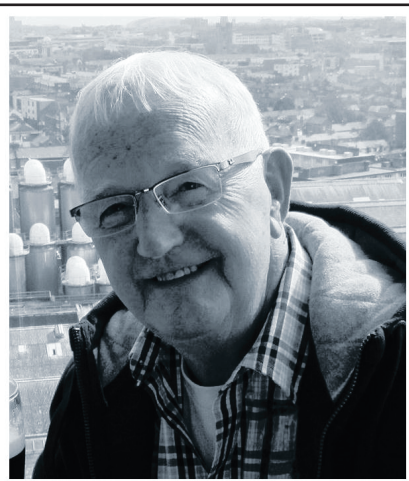


MELVIN, Patrick 1943 - 2015
