## Silver Creek School community dedicates Run to young student


This year's Terry Fox Run at Silver Creek Public School, held last week, was dedicated to the memory of a Grade 1 student at the school who died of cancer in June.

The family of Addison Jenner Rolke is in the process of establishing a fund in her name called Addison's Wish Foundation that will be directed to charities that provide support for families with hospitalized children and cancer prevention.

A park bench dedicated to Addison will soon be installed at the Georgetown branch of the Halton Hills Public Library.

Close to \$2.000 was raised at Silver Creek for Addison's Wish Foundation and a little more than \$2,300 in contributions came from the school's Terry Fox Run, with money still to come in.
