



Halton Police leads joint raid on meth drug lab operation

A month-long Halton Police investigation has led to the dismantling of a drug lab and the arrest of four people after a raid with two other police services last Thursday.

Halton Police, Peel Police and the OPP raided three homes in Brampton, Toronto and Vaughan, seizing about five kilograms of crystal methamphetamine from the Brampton home.

Peel Police Const. Rachel Gibbs of Peel Police said some 10 homes near 22 Midsummer Dr. near McVean Dr. and Queen St. had to be evacuated for about an hour at 5 p.m. following the discovery of a meth lab.

According to Halton Police, the investigation began, on Sept. 29, when the Halton Police Drug, Gun and Gang Unit responded to a discarded methamphetamine lab at the road-side on Sixth Line in Halton Hills.

Through investigation, police identified Phuong Dang as a suspect responsible for the methamphetamine lab.

Police conducted surveillance on Dang and observed him at a residence on Midsummer Dr. in Brampton. Based on Dang's behaviour police formed the belief that Dang was
