Q: What is a Will?

A: A Will is records of a person's directions regarding the disposition of his or her estate after death. Typically, a Will includes clauses such as: identification of the person making the Will; revocation of all previous Wills; appointment of executors and guardians; guardianship clause; payment of debts and taxes; specific gifts or legacies; residual bequests (including trusts); land and administrative clauses.

Why Make a Will?

Many benefits result from making a Will, including enabling you to:

- Decide who will handle your estate and distribute your assets.
- Decide who will receive your assets in accordance with your wishes. (e.g., avoids your assets being given to the government if you have no heirs or family)
- Reduce or defer taxes;
- Avoid disputes and litigation (e.g., by providing directions for special property or items);
- Create trusts, such as for children or spouses;
- Donate to charity upon death;
