“If there is paraphernalia found, we do advise police and they begin an investigation from there.”

Harris asked Mike Gordon, the supervisor for parks and cemeteries, to schedule a meeting with the woman who stumbled across the structures, but by Nov. 16, she still hadn’t heard from him.

“If they’re turning to theft as well, it’s gone too far,” she said. “They’re not just building a

fort because it’s a cool hangout. They’re using it all year round.”

Barrett Gabriel, Acting Staff Sgt. for the Halton Regional Police, encourages anyone witnessing any suspicious activity to report it immediately and contact police at 905-878-5581.

“We always encourage them to call us,” he said. “If they think there’s suspected drug activity going on, or they know there is, call us and we will come.”
