would be concerned, however, I think that we as the Town have advocated to the MTO to make changes with the no parking," Mills said.

"We have co-operated in terms of providing the contacts that we've dealt with at MTO so that either he or his representatives could talk to them. Again, I don't have the ability to make any changes to that road."

Noah Malinoski, owner of the Tim Hor-

tons' location, said he empathizes with the Attards' situation. The store does have a drive-around option for truckers, and landscapers come once a week to pick up litter around the property.

"I get the frustration. The thing is we can't control our customers and where they park. It's human habit," Malinoski said.

"We've done everything we can to be good neighbours. If they're going to put a barrier up or something, we'd support that."
