

# Halton Police charge Acton man with marijuana possession

A traffic stop by a Halton Regional Police officer conducting speed enforcement in Georgetown resulted in a drug charge for an Acton man last week.

A vehicle was pulled over for speeding in the area of Trafalgar Rd. and 17 Sideroad. During interaction with the driver, the officer became suspicious about the contents of the vehicle and a search was performed, Halton Police said.

Approximately 164 grams of marijuana was discovered along with a quantity of cash.

Charged with possession of marijuana for the purpose of trafficking was Andrew Farrugia, 27.
