PIC to outline 2016 roadwork in Georgetown

Watermain and wastewater main replacement/rehabilitation and road resurfacing/reconstruction will be focused on Wards 3 & 4, Georgetown, starting in the Spring of 2016.

The Town of Halton Hills and the Region of Halton are planning to perform improvements to the following streets:

- Crombie Pl., from Delrex Blvd. to end, road surfacing.
- Dale Gate, from Prince Charles Dr. to Mc-Intyre Cres. watermain and road resurfacing
- Delma Ct., from Heslop Ct. to end, road surfacing
- Garnet Dr., from Rexway Dr. to Delrex Blvd., watermain and road resurfacing
- Gibbons Pl., from Prince Charles Dr. to end, road construction
- Heslop Ct., from Rexway Dr. to end, road resurfacing
- McIntyre Cres., from Rexway Dr. to end, watermain and road resurfacing
 - Norton Cres., from Delrex Blvd. to end,

from watermain and road resurfacing

- Rexway Dr., from Guelph St. to Delrex Blvd., watermain, wastewater main and road resurfacing
- Rexway Dr., from Heslop Ct. to Delrex Blvd., watermain and road resurfacing
- Terry Ct., Delrex Blvd. to end, road resurfacing.
