As part of the ancient traditions surrounding St. George's Day celebrations, a feast of wild boar was often held. In keeping with this tradition, St. George's Anglican Church in Georgetown will host a wild boar dinner on St. George's Eve, April 22, in the Parish Hall.

The menu will include roast European wild boar, Spatzle (tiny dumplings), Rotkohl (red cabbage and apples), parsley potatoes, water rye bread, salads and Kirsch Torte (Black Forest cake).

The wild boar served at dinner will come from a farm in Sebringville, near Stratford, where a herd of purebred boar are raised from genuine Black Forest breeding stock. The boar are grown in a forest area under natural conditions.




