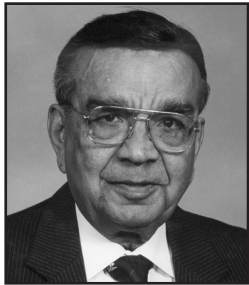


DEATHS
