Martin said the township is "not getting its money's worth from the engineering consultants." He used the \$200,000 estimated cost of mould abatement for Rockmosa Community Centre as an example. He said they should have used the public health department for tests but instead "they called in more engineers."

The mayor was also unhappy with sewage infiltration studies. He

said council agreed to a 12 month, four season study, but received a six month study instead. He said, "There is too much variation in the volume of waste water and we need to find out where the water is getting in to the system. The cost paid to Guelph is based on volume so we need answers. This affects everyone's water bill."

He added, "As a council, we are overlooking rather than overseeing."
