Roman Catholic.

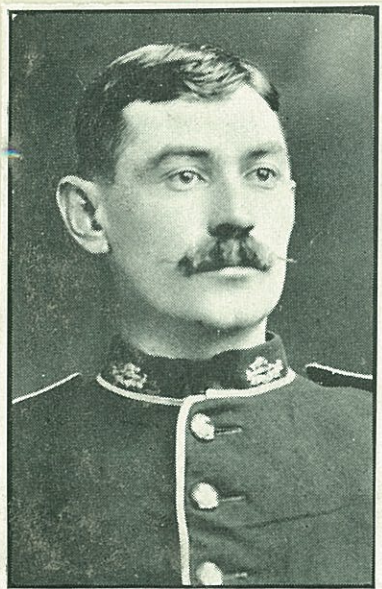
Born Sept. 8, 1880 educated at Hespeler Public School.

Trained at Valcartier, left for overseas Sept. 28, 1914, trained at Salisbury Plains left for France Feb. 6, 1915.

He was accidentally killed at Nantes, France on Feb. 12, 1915 and is buried at Bouteillers Cemetery, Nantes, France.

He was a veteran of the South African War, going over with 4 th Canadian Mounted Rifles April 1902 and was honorable discharged that same year.
