Sergt. Leander Wahl, son of Andrew Wahl of St. Jacobs, enlisted at London Dec. 13th 1915. He trained at Carling Camp and Camp Bordon. He left Halifax for overseas on Aug. 22nd 1916, on the Olympic. In England he trained at Witley Camp and Bramshott, and served as Pay Sergeant for 135th Infantry Batt., on Staff of Command Paymaster Liphook, Hauts, and Cashier C.A.P.C. Supply Sales Dept. Bramshott area. He received his stripes and four blue chevrons Sept. 11th 1916. He sailed from Liverpool Aug. 17th 1919 on the S. S. Belgic for Halifax, and received his discharge Aug. 31st 1919.
