

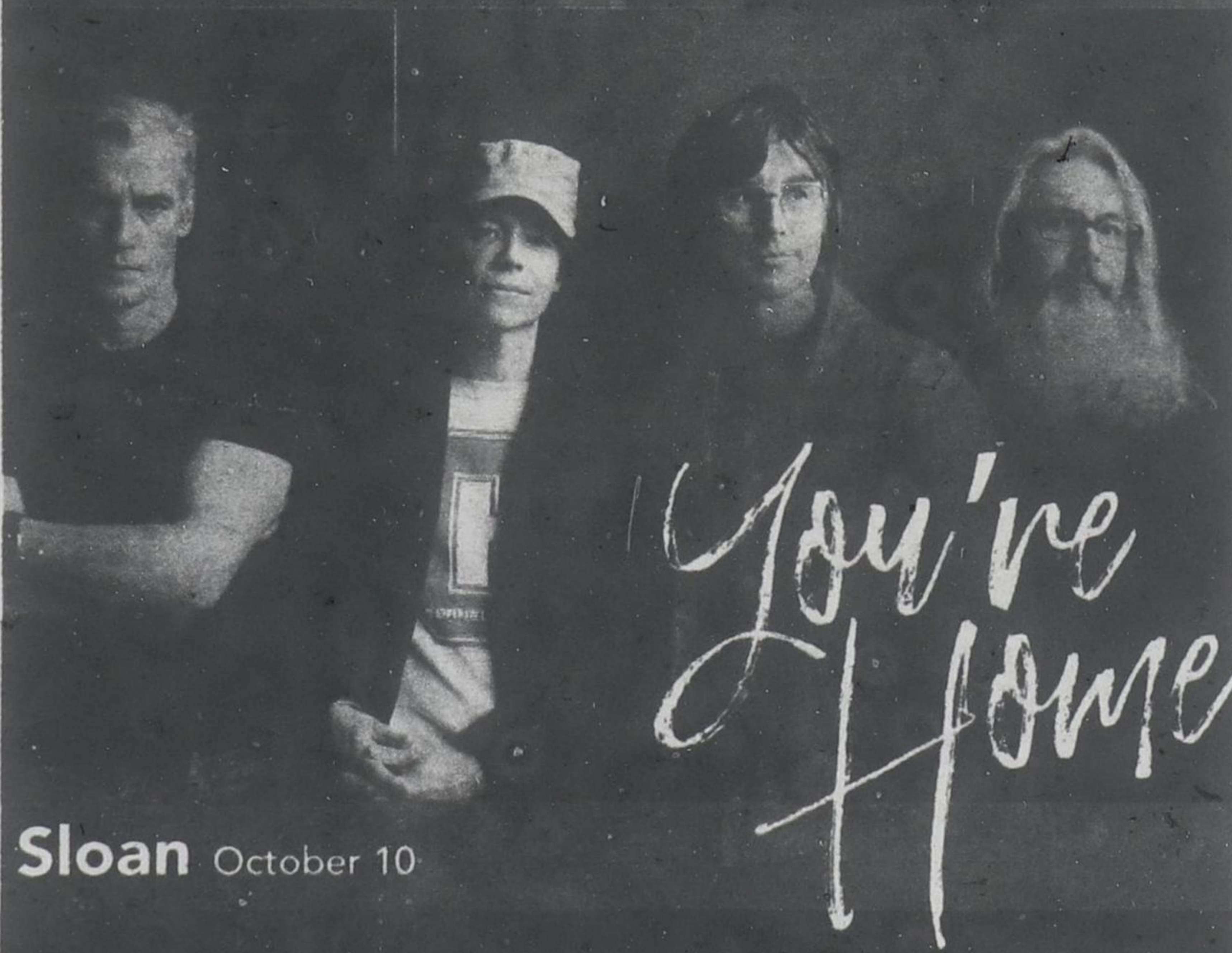

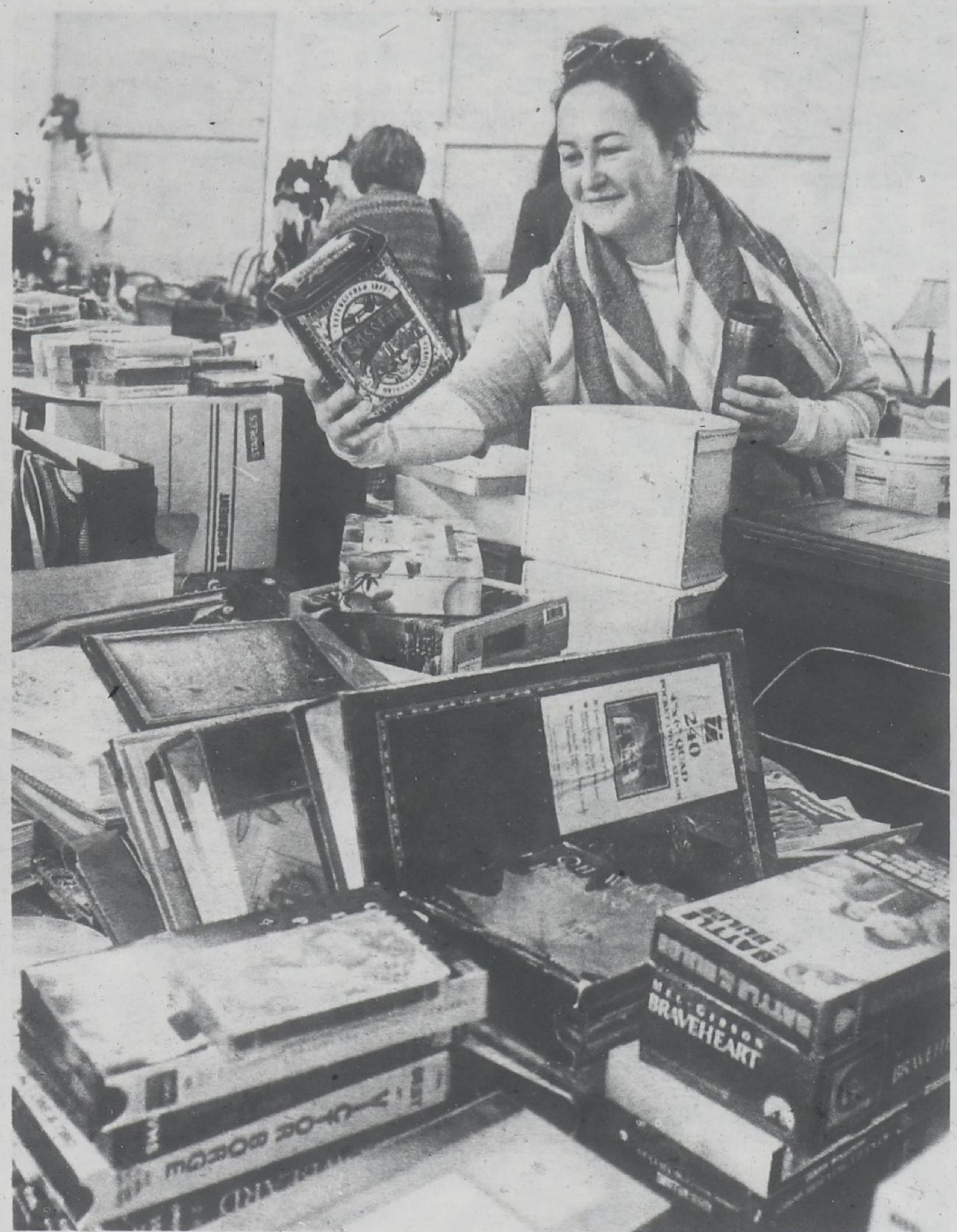

SIGN UP FOR HIKE FOR HOSPICE

Miltonians are being asked to go the distance to help establish a local hospice.

Those with the Townsend-Smith Foundation are hoping to bolster those efforts with a strong turnout to their second annual Hike for Hospice.

It's set for Saturday, May 25 at Milton Commu-

nity Park (behind Milton Sports Centre).

The five kilometre route winds its way through the streets of the Willmott neighbourhood.

Registration at Park C is slated for 9 a.m. and the hike gets underway at 10 a.m.

"A hospice is so needed locally, and would bring so

much value to our community," said Townsend-Smith Foundation board chair John Barrett whose organization aims to build a 15,000-square-foot facility with 10 beds in north Halton.
