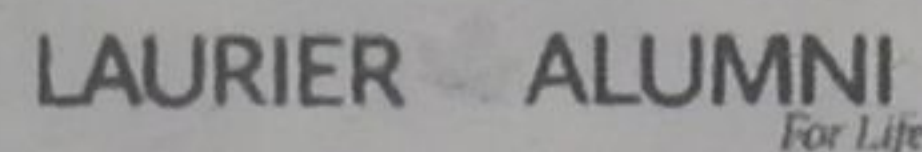
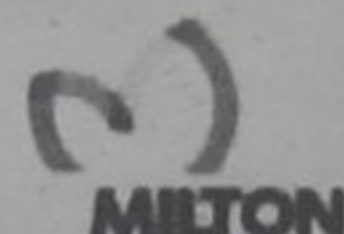
Laurier Milton Lecture Series
