PELLETTERIO, Joseph

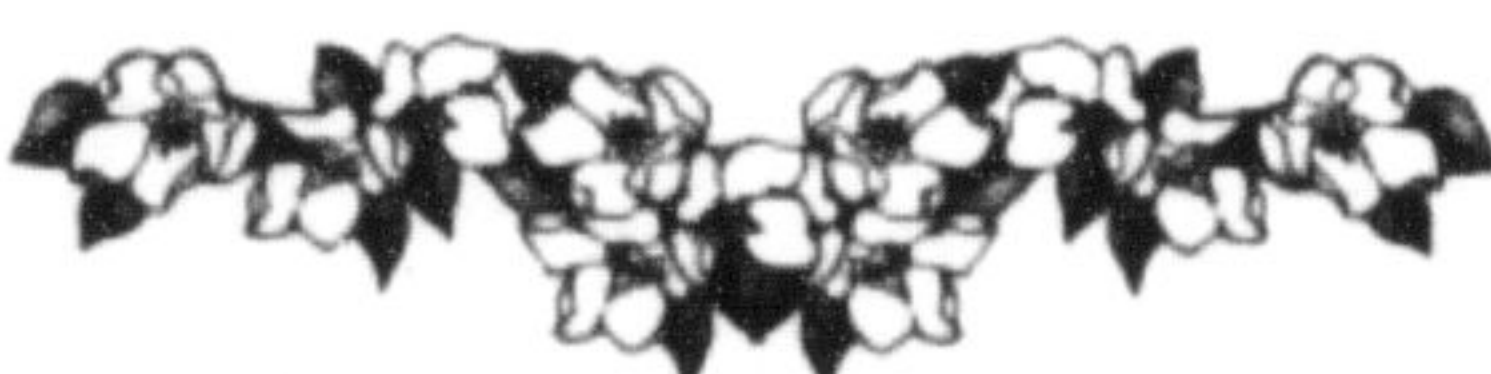
