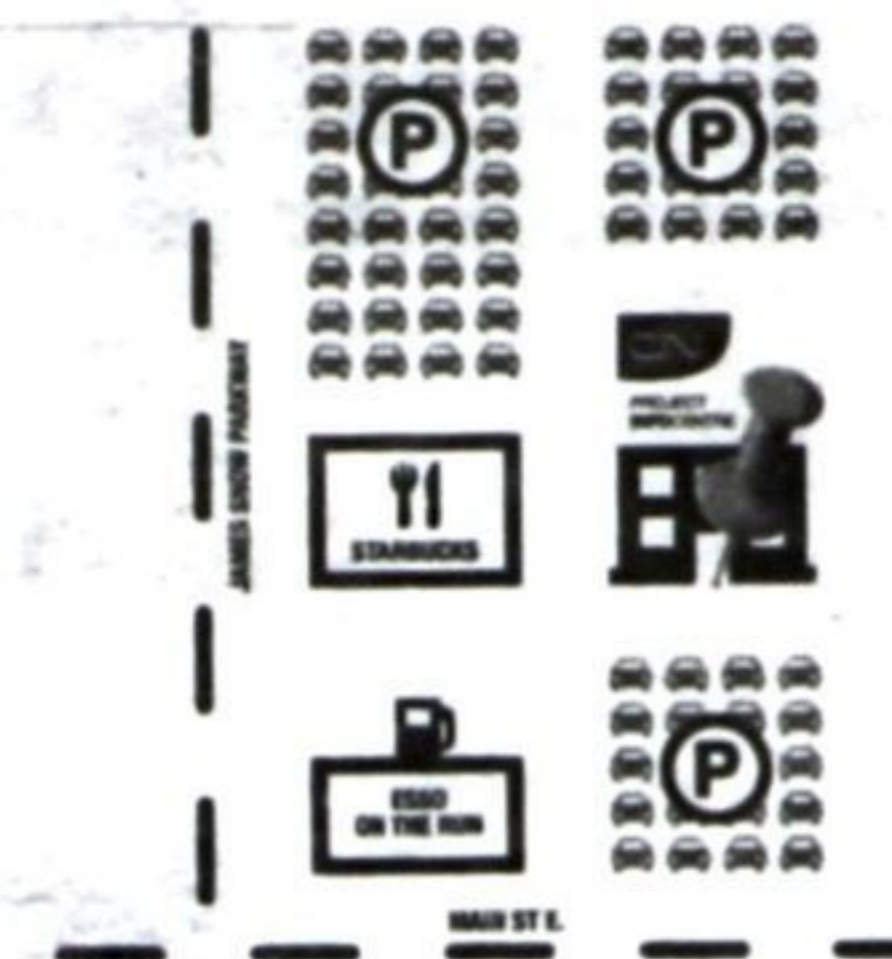
Can you dig it?
