Esther stars in CBC doc

Campbellville's world-renowned pig is about to get even more famous as she makes her debut on CBC television. Esther will appear in *The Nature of Things* documentary *Think Like An Animal* tonight (Thursday) at 8 p.m. Viewers are in for some startling revelations in the CBC documentary, as they watch amazing creatures, from sperm whales to hummingbirds, illustrate their 'brain power.'

Myths debunked

In *Think Like An Animal* viewers will discover new research that debunks old myths about how animals really think and demonstrates their complex cognitive skills. The film will undoubtedly prompt many viewers to look at the animal kingdom in a new light. Viewers will watch a cross-section of unlikely species proving their smarts — among them, bearded dragons that problem-solve, fish that deceive each other, hummingbirds with incredible memories, and of course, Esther, the 650-pound pig with sophisticated abilities. "Filming animals in the wild has really opened my eyes," said director Leora Eisen. "We often assume our dogs and cats are clever, but there's actually a whole range of wildlife who are incredibly smart."

Eisen travelled to South Africa, Britain, the Caribbean, and the Canadian Rockies to film animals and to meet with biologists, psychologists
