> Oxford Learning's CAM rule for setting goals: Goals need to be Clear, Achievable, and Measurable. Here's how students can apply the CAM rule.

- Clear: Make specific goals that are not too broad in scope. The goal shouldn't be "improve my science grade", but "I want to understand the periodic table of elements and mitosis."
- Achievable: Keep goals realistic. A "C-" student has a better chance of getting a "C+" on the next test than an "A".
- Measurable. By setting a goal that has benchmarks, you can track success. Last week Mike only knew 3 periodic elements; this week he knows 10!

The CAM method for setting goals makes academic resolutions easy to keep. Students won't get discouraged and abandon their resolutions because they can track their progress, no matter how minor the achievement is.
