Red Cross shelters. There are still 14 shelters in operation and over 5,000 people are being fed. Three hundred trained disaster workers from all sections of the country are now in Texas and Louisiana assisting local volun-

teers with a continuing mass care program and planning with families to meet long-term recovery needs.

Latest reports have not been received relative to the damage on the Eastern Coast but it is understood that Red Cross shelters have been opened wherever there was a need for assistance.

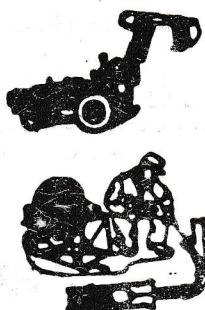
The funds of the National Red Cross have been severely drained and Chapters not affected are asked to make an appeal for funds to assist in this over-all job of disaster rehabilitation as
