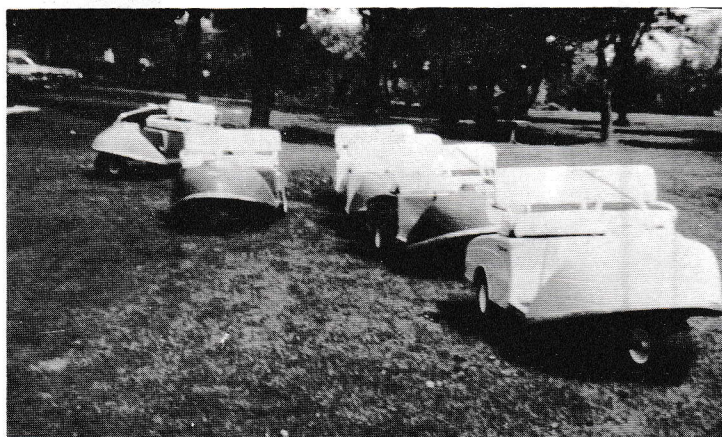
#### RUMMAGE SALE IN MC CULLOM LAKE A BIG SUCCESS
