POSTAL ADDRESS SYSTEM MEETING TO BE HELD

A meeting concerning the new postal address system will be held on Thursday evening, September 22, at 8 P.M. in the McHenry High School. The purpose of this meeting is to inform residents of the area of this new address system to be adopted by the McHenry Post Office in the next several months. Postmaster James Hettermann will explain this new system in detail. The public is invited to attend.

U. S. POST OFFICE NEWS

Postmaster J. W. Hettermann states that one of the most commonly asked questions at the post office is what can be done to prevent receipt of unsolicited and unwanted third-class mail matter, especially advertising circulars.

According to Postmaster Hettermann, patrons may refuse unwanted circular matter, by not opening it, and endorsing it "Refused" and handing it back to the carrier or placing it in a collection box. This would then cause the piece to be returned to the sender, provided

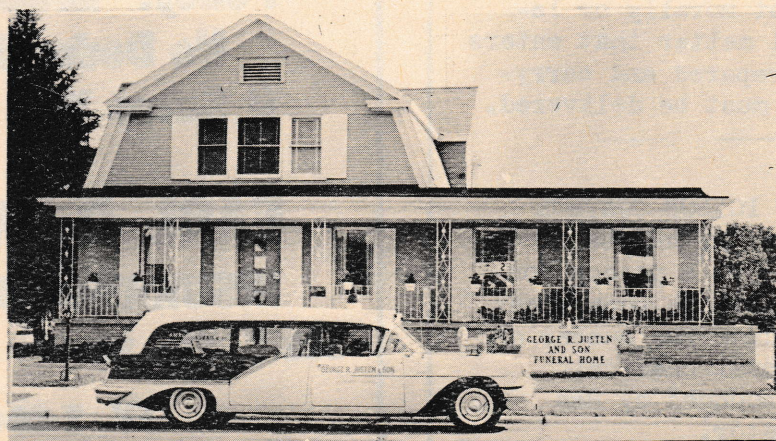
