Books are still popular at library



ummer Reading is now in full swing, and by the looks of it, reading is alive and well amongst the kids in Oakville.

As of this week, there have been about 3,000 sign-ups and 1,000 returning participants, and the numbers continue to grow.

Books are by far the most popular format in which children are doing their reading, with DVDs, magazines and audiobooks following far behind.

If you're looking for some recommendations on which books to read next, the top five reported items are Diary of a Wimpy Kid by Jeff Kinney, And Then It Happened by M. Wade, Harry Potter and the Deathly Hallows by J.K. Rowling, Dork Diaries by Rachel Renee Russell and Pink Around the Rink by Victoria Kann.

New this year at the library, we have weekly drop-ins that allow children to further immerse themselves in the Summer Reading 'Splash' theme. They involve games, a craft, and for the older kids, an interactive book talk. A weekly handout sheet includes word searches, puzzles, mazes and jokes. Drop-ins have been popular with both children and parents, and give children the ability to participate in themed programs that facilitate reading and learning.

- · Exploring the Seven Seas: Aug.
- Sailors Wanted, Learn the Ropes:
 - Something's Fishy: Aug. 15-19
 - Splash Blast: Aug. 22-26
