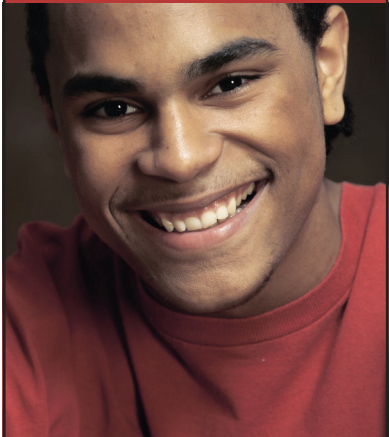

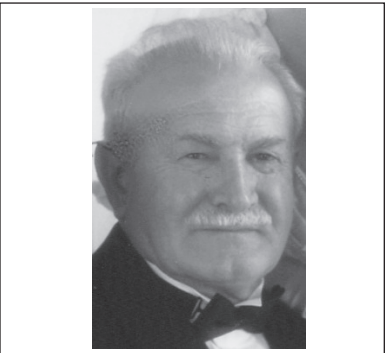
TOTEN, Jack
