Having a solid cast has helped McKim create that family closeness on stage. This, he said, was created before the rehearsal process. It was

done during the audition process.

"If you cast good players, the rest of the job is easy," McKim said.

"You have to try to find the right family. If you find the right family through the audition process and casting, then as the director, my job

is already done. Then it's just guidance after that."

After that, he said he just had to help the actors work out the kinks in the delivery of the jokes that lighten the mood.

Dametto added that the cast has grown into a family of its own during the rehearsal process.

The play runs from Jan. 5-7 and Jan. 11-14 with shows at 8 p.m. There is a 2 p.m. matinee showing on Jan. 8 as well.
