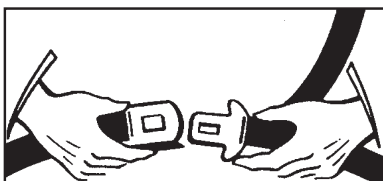

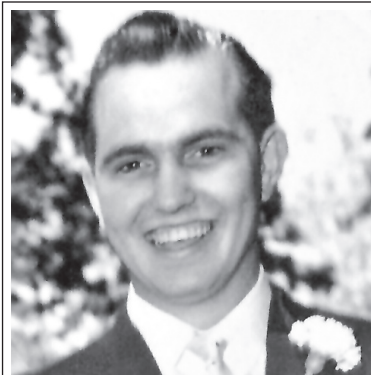

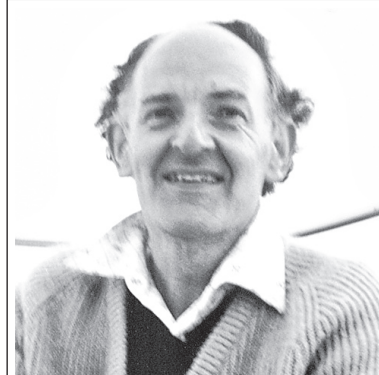
## Obituaries
