Knights of Columbus free throw competition draws kids ages 9-14

Winners and runners-up at last weekend's Knights of Columbus Basketball Free Throw Championship in Oakville will get right back to the line tomorrow for the district championships in Burlington.

The event, held at St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Secondary School, featured 138 boys and girls ages 9-14, many of whom won school competitions to advance to Saturday's affair.

"We had amazing participation from over 90 per cent of our Catholic elementary and secondary schools throughout the Oakville area," said Andrew Eckstein of the Knights of Columbus.

On hand to support the event were local MP John Oliver, MPP Kevin Flynn, Mayor Rob Burton, Halton Catholic District School Board Superintendent Tim Overholt, Oakville councillor Ray Chisholm and K of C district deputy Steve Reynolds.

The competition also included Special Olympics kids sinking baskets. Those results will be published when they're available.

The top two shooters from each of the 10 divisions will head to Corpus Christi Catholic Secondary School tomorrow (Friday) in Burlington in the next step of a competition that eventually determines North American champions.
