A coaching legacy difficult to equal

Anyone who had anything to do with amateur sports in Ontario over the past 40 years, would know the name Harvey Singleton.

Singleton succumbed to cancer over the weekend leaving behind a coaching legacy difficult to equal.

Locally, the longtime Oakville resident was best known as the physical education department head at White Oaks Secondary School between 1965 and 1987, where his more well known graduates included future NFLers Tony Mandarich (now retired) and Mike Vanderjagt.

He coached basketball, track and field and football at the high school, university and national levels.

He was also an assistant coach for the McMaster University men's basketball team and director of Toronto's Track and Field Centre at York University for many years.

Originally from Chicago, Singleton played for the Toronto Argos in 1952 and prior to that suited up with the Harlem Globetrotters.
