

## Fire safety demo Saturday

First Alert and Lansing Buildall have joined forces for a series of day-long fire safety events this Saturday in conjunction with National Fire Safety Week.

The Oakville public awareness forum takes place at the Lansing store at 399 Speers Rd. from 10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Local fire personnel will be on hand for part of the day to answer questions from the public and to distribute valuable information.

This year's theme of Fire Prevention Week, which ends Saturday, is "Fire Drills: The Great Escape," which emphasizes the importance of developing and

practicing a fire escape plan for the home and the workplace.

Between 90% and 95% of Ontario homes have smoke alarms, according to the Ontario Fire Marshal's Office. However, 40% to 50% of these are disconnected, or not operating properly.

## Labour law expert speaks Oct. 21st

Employment and labour law specialist, Ed Canning, is the guest speaker at a breakfast discussing

— **Conflict Resolution on the Job** — on Oct. 21st.
