The weekend is filled with performances from bands such as Juliana Theory, Break of Dawn, Cru Jones, Capture the Flag, Ignorance Never Settles, In Truth, As we Once Were, and many other punk and metal bands from various places in southern Ontario and the United States.

The festival open to all ages, and passes are available at the door. Passes are \$8 for Friday night, \$10 for Saturday night, or \$15 for both.


