Drive around your neighbor-Talk to homeowners about their projects - most people are delighted to share their renovation experiences.

4. Get estimates

Get two or three different bids; more are usually not required. Make sure that you provide all the renovators with the same detailed information - it is important that they bid on the same job, or you will not be able to compare estimates. This information could be a description of the job including sketches, drawings, photographs and measurements.

For estimates involving major structural changes, such as additions or moving walls, renovators may also need a set of plans that includes site and floor plans, elevations, and detail drawings.

The cost of plans ranges from \$500 to \$800; however, the plan forms the basis for the estimating process and will also be used to obtain building permits.

The renovator may be able to provide you with a plan, based on your drawings and sketches; many, renovators will absorb the cost of the plan if they are chosen for the job.

Be honest and open about your budget. The renovator will be able to make suggestions that will help you stay within you budget or provide alternative ideas to stretch your dollars fur-
