Welcome Wellspring, a special fundraising dinner for Wellspring Halton-Peel, is set for Wednesday, June 16th at Le Dome Banquet Hall.

The evening is also a celebration of mayor Ann Mulvale's 50th birthday and her 10th year in office. Wellspring House, an innovative treatment and support facility for cancer patients, will soon be a part of Oakville's Uptown Core Park.

The Mayor's Reception, sponsored by Royal Bank, commences

at 6:15 p.m. followed by dinner at 7 p.m. This "celebration of life" promises to be full of surprises and during her keynote address, Mulvale will reminisce about her highs and lows in office.

Other sponsors of the evening include AstraZeneca, Canadian Airlines Employees Charitable Foundation, IVI Checkmate, Laidlaw, Mack Truck, Petro-Canada and SmithKline Beecham. The community itself has rallied behind this cause and more than half of the tickets have already been requested.

The Wellspring Cancer Support Foundation is well known to those receiving treatment at Princess Margaret Hospital - 25% of whom are patients from west of Toronto.

With Credit Valley Hospital now the designated cancer treatment centre for Halton and Peel, a Wellspring satellite centre in Oakville is an ideal location.

Wellspring was established in 1992 to help fill the void between the cancer care system and support services. At present, Wellspring is located in the non-institutional setting of a coach

house in downtown Toronto. There, cancer patients and their families receive comfort, support, practical information and more.

Funding comes from individual donations and from corporations and foundations. This assistance allows more than 30 programs - from art therapy to yoga and meditation - to be made available at no cost. There is also a lending library and programs for the children of patients.

The programs are open to all cancer patients regardless of where they live.
